









# Year R's Home Learning Letter (Wednesday)







	<p>Activities this week are based around the story 'Supertato'. Don't worry if you don't have a copy at home. I have it and will read it and put on tapestry along with others from the series.</p>
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<p><b>Phonics</b></p>	<p>Practise reading all phase 2 and 3 tricky words and <b>have like some come</b>.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Look at the word <b>was</b>. Read it together. Put it into a sentence for understanding.</li> <li>Discuss the letters required for each phoneme, using letter names. Discuss 'o' sound. <i>We often talk about it being wazzy was!</i></li> </ul>		
<p><b>Reading</b></p>	<p>Chose a book to read. Read the story together. Become a word detective, how many tricky words can you find in it, create a tally.</p>		
<p><b>Writing</b></p>	<p>Using your story map from yesterday, write a sentence each for the beginning, middle and end of the story. You could add more details if you wish. For some children one sentence will be enough, but you could ask your grown up to scribe your story for you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Don't forget to snuggle your letters into words, leaving gaps between them.</i></li> <li><i>Use the sound and word mats in your learning pack.</i></li> </ul>		
<p><b>Handwriting</b></p>	<p>Practise letters:                      Remember to always start at the top and bump your letter on the line.</p>  <p>See information in pack for more guidance. <b>Practise i and u from the window cleaner family</b> Challenge: write the words - ink into up until</p>
