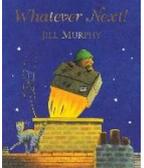
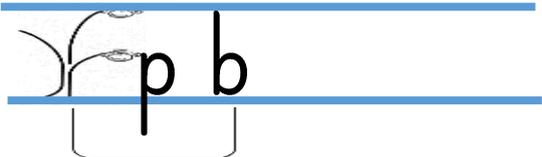


## Year R's Home Learning Letter (Wednesday) 20.5.20

<b>Reading</b>	<p><b>Read and discuss these sentences</b> Were there some chimps at the moon? Yuck! There was a paint brush in the rocket ship! <b>Writing</b>	<p>Use the objects you have found in the maths task. Write lists of what will fit through Baby bear's rocket door and what will not fit through Baby bear's rocket door.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Don't forget to snuggle your letters into words, leaving gaps between them.</li> <li>Use the sound and word mats in your learning pack.</li> </ul>
