



Year 1 Home Learning Letter – 24.04.20

Reading	<p>Read a book by yourself or with a grown up for 15 minutes.</p> <p style="font-size: 2em; color: #008000;">Reading Challenge: Make a new front cover for your book. <i>How would you make it look exciting so others want to read it?</i></p>		
Writing		<p>Write a letter to your grown-ups. Persuade them that it would be a good idea for you to have the new pet you drew yesterday. Tell them why it would be a good idea.</p>
