


## Year 3 Home Learning Letter – 26.03.20

<b>Spelling</b>	<p><b>Rule: Words with the 'k' sound spelt 'ch'</b> (e.g. ache, anchor, Christmas, school, choir, echo)</p> <p>Write out all of the words above and any of the other words you have managed to think of with 'ch' making the 'k' sound. Use your favourite spelling strategy to practise them: pyramid words, QuickWrite, rainbow writing, drawing pictures or boxing up the letters.</p> <p><i>You could... log onto Spelling Shed to test yourself on some of the Year 3 curriculum words.</i></p>
<b>Reading</b>	<p>Spend at least 10 minutes reading your coloured sticker book. Choose your favourite word or phrase from the part you have read. Write it in your book and explain why it is your favourite word. Does it have a cool meaning? Does it sound nice when you read it out loud?</p> <p><i>You could... read out loud to someone at home and use different voices for the characters.</i></p>
<b>Writing</b>	<div style="display: flex; align-items: center;">  <div style="margin-left: 20px;"> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Save our habitat!</b></p> <p>Using your persuasive paragraph from yesterday, make a persuasive leaflet for humans to ask them to leave animal habitats alone. You'll need to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Explain why animal habitats are important</li> <li>• Give some information on how to identify animal habitats</li> <li>• Have some cute pictures of animals</li> </ul> <p style="background-color: #e1f5fe; padding: 2px;">Don't forget to use Kinetic Letters and the correct spelling and punctuation in your writing!</p> </div> </div>
<b>Handwriting</b>	<div style="display: flex;"> <div style="flex: 1;"> <p>In lizard position, draw trees next to your margin and write a full sentence using words that use the Fisher Family letters:</p> <p><i>In my house, I go around jumping on fluffy pillows.</i></p> </div> <div style="flex: 2;"> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Fisher Family Letter Trails</b> <span style="float: right;">Strand</span></p>  </div> </div>
<b>Maths</b>	<p>How many different ways can you represent the number <b>763</b>?</p> <p>Think about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- pictorial representations (candles on a cake, dienes, Numicon, place value counters)</li> <li>- number sentences (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division)</li> <li>- facts you know about it (odd or even, where do you see the number in your life?, is it part of a times table?)</li> </ul>

<b>Choose whatever you want to do from these 3 jobs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create a 20 minute long PE lesson and teach it to someone else in your house. You might want to watch (and take part in!) some on YouTube first to get some inspiration for your lesson.</li> <li>• Remind yourself of the numbers 1-10 in French.
