




## Year 3 Home Learning Letter – 27.03.20

<b>Spelling</b>	<p><b>Rule: Words with the 'k' sound spelt 'ch'</b> (e.g. ache, anchor, Christmas, school, choir, echo)</p> <p>Ask someone at home to test you on the words above and on any of the others words you have managed to think of with 'ch' making the 'k' sound. Agree on a prize for you to win if you get them all correct!</p> <p><i>You could... log onto Spelling Shed to test yourself on some of the Year 3 curriculum words.</i></p>								
<b>Reading</b>	<p>Spend at least 10 minutes reading your library book. Think about an action the main character has done. Why do you think they have done that?</p> <p><i>You could... read out loud to someone at home and use different voices for the characters.</i></p>								
<b>Writing</b>	<div style="display: flex; align-items: center;">  <div style="margin-left: 20px;"> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Save our habitat!</b></p> <p>Complete your persuasive leaflet from yesterday. You might want to add more detail to your reasons why we should leave animal habitats alone. You could also make a persuasive poster using some of the pictures and facts from your leaflet. Your poster will need to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Have small amounts of writing</li> <li>Be eye-catching</li> </ul> <p style="background-color: #e1f5fe; padding: 2px;">Don't forget to use Kinetic Letters and the correct spelling and punctuation in your writing!</p> </div> </div>								
<b>Handwriting</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Animal Position Challenge!</b></p> <p>Hold each of the animals poses for as long as you can and write down your time (make sure you start the timer before you get into your position!). Have a rest and then have another go – can you beat the time from your first try?</p> <p><i>You could... challenge other members of your family to do the same! Who can hold each position the longest?</i></p>
