


Year 1 Home Learning Letter – 29.04.20

Reading	Reading for 15 minutes – can you make a den to read in today?		
Writing	<p>Anyone Seen My Dragon?</p> <p>Read or listen to the poem again. Remember to join in with actions!</p> <p>Draw your own dragon or any pet you would like to have!</p> <p>Label your drawing with words to describe what it looks like.</p> <p>Think about describing it's ... ears... eyes... fur/skin...tail....nose...legs....feet</p>		
Handwriting	<p>This week we are revising the fisher family.</p> <p>Practise your animal positions.</p> <p>Practise picking up tiny bits of real or imaginary rice with your holding fingers.</p> <p>Draw a tree and practise y.</p> <div style="text-align: center; margin-top: 10px;">  </div>		
Maths	<p>Today's White Rose lesson is building on yesterday's lesson about finding quarters: https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/Remember you can choose to try a different year's lesson if you want a challenge.</p> <p>Alternative work: Collect together 16 objects – use them to find half of 16 and a quarter of 16.
