We have been really proud of how well the children have returned to school for the first fully open week back after Lockdown 3. Thank you for adapting to the changed drop off and pick up times. We have worked to ensure we have resolved the sibling combinations coming in and out at the correct times. Please do let us know if this is still not working for you.

It has been very calm and settled around the classrooms and the corridors and children have responded well to using the bubble rules again. These are an essential part of keeping children safe in school. Teachers have begun the process of observing how well the children can remember what they have been taught before and how confident they are at applying this in learning activities this week. This forms the basis of the curriculum that continues to be taught, enabling children to build up their resilience for learning again. During these meetings we will be able to update you on how your child has settled back in to school and how their learning is progressing.
