What tricky words are in the book? Which phonic sounds did you recognise? What did you find tricky? Talk it through.

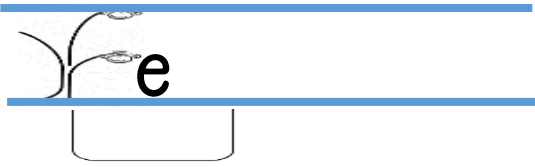
Writing:
