It is important to us that we use your responses to help us to continue to provide the teaching that your child needs whilst we are still in lockdown, whether your child is at home or at school.

So you are clear, any merits that are awarded before 1pm on Friday are added to the totals, certificates awarded, shared on the newsletter and added to Monday assembly for the following week.
